City Council Proceedings  
February 9, 2021

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Tilden met in regular session on Tuesday, February 9, 2021 at 7:30pm at the Tilden Public Library Lied Auditorium. Notice of the meeting was given by publication in The Tilden Citizen/Meadow Grove News on January 27, 2021 and by posting at four locations within the city. –

(1) Mayor Leo Botsford opened the meeting at 7:30pm and the Clerk recorded the proceedings.

(2) Declaration of open meetings act.

(3) ROLL CALL: Mayor Leo Botsford. Council Members: Allen Smidt, Travis Rutjens, Lisa Meyer, Darrell Wyatt, Patricia Decker, Molly Navratil.

(4) PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

(5) MAYOR'S OPEN DISCUSSION – Mayor Botsford wanted to thank the street maintenance personnel for doing a very good job at snow removal and to thank the citizens for being cooperative with removing vehicles from the streets during a snow emergency.

8) ORDINANCE 549 – AN ORDINANCE MAKING A CHANGE OF ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN LANDS LOCATED IN THE CITY OF TILDEN, NEBRASKA UNDER THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY SECTION 19-922 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF NEBRASKA, 1943. Motion made by Wyatt to introduce Ordinances 549, waive the three required readings and publication in pamphlet form, seconded by Rutjens. RCV: Yes – Smidt, Rutjens, Meyer, Wyatt, Decker, Navratil. No – None. Approved.

(9) ORDINANCE 550 – AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TILDEN, NEBRASKA, PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF THE PORTION OF FIRST STREET WEST OF CENTER STREET AND EAST OF PINE STREET IN TILDEN, NEBRASKA, ANTELOPE COUNTY, NEBRASKA; PROVIDING FOR THE REVERSION OF THE VACATED STREET TO THE ADJACENT LANDOWNERS; AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND ESTABLISHING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE. Tabled until further discussions with adjacent landowners.

(11) SDL – Motion made by Smidt to approve an SDL request from Players Club on March 20, 2021 in the City auditorium, seconded by Rutjens. RCV: Yes – Navratil, Decker, Wyatt, Meyer, Rutjens, Smidt. No – None. Approved.




