The learning climate in our school is evaluated at least every other school year.

GRADUATE FOLLOW UP

Every year the high school Guidance Counselor conducts a follow up study of Elkhorn Valley graduates from one and five years past. The results are reviewed and recommendations considered.

Over the last two years, 63% of Elkhorn Valley graduates have gone on to post-secondary education, 31% have entered the work force, and 6% have joined the Armed Forces.

Remedial math and reading are offered K-6 through special federal funding.

Resource rooms for students with mild learning problems are offered K-6 and 7-12. Moderately handicapped students are served in a LSC program.

Vocational programs in business education, family & consumer science, and industrial education are offered by the high school.

Educational Service Unit #8 serves the district with speech, psychological, staff development, media services, and provides a school nurse to the school five days each week.

School District #80 in Madison, Antelope, Pierce, and Boone Counties covers 212 square miles and has an affiliated valuation of \$719,551,091. It is a class 3, K-12 school district fully accredited by the State of Nebraska.
