City Council Proceedings
July 14, 2020

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Tilden met in regular session on Tuesday, July 14, 2020 at 7:30pm at the Tilden Public Library Lied Auditorium. Notice of the meeting was given by publication in The Tilden Citizen/Meadow Grove News on June 24, 2020 and by posting at four locations within the city.

- (1) Mayor Leo Botsford opened the meeting at 7:30pm and the Clerk recorded the proceedings.
 - (2) Declaration of open meetings act.
 - (3) ROLL CALL: Mayor Leo Botsford. Council Members: Tom Zwingman, Travis Rutjens, Al Smidt, Molly Navratil, Patricia Decker, Darrell Wyatt.
 - (4) PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE
 - (5) MAYOR'S OPEN DISCUSSION – Alan Rutjens and Sam Johnsen, representing the Tilden Young Mens Club, requested permission to use City property for mud volleyball, beer garden, and fireworks. The Council agreed that if appropriate permits were obtained and waivers are signed by participants the City would not have any objections.
 - (6) CONSENT AGENDA – Rutjens moved to approve the consent agenda, seconded by Decker. RCV: Yes – Navratil, Decker, Wyatt, Zwingman, Rutjens, Smidt. Approved.
 - (7) REPORTS BY CITY DEPARTMENTS-Written reports are kept on file in the City office and are available for public viewing.
 - (8) BUILDING PERMITS – Motion made by Rutjens to have the Clerk send a letter allowing 15 days for the resident to file a building permit application and pay the \$25 fee, seconded by Navratil. RCV: Yes – Wyatt, Navratil, Smidt, Rutjens, Zwingman. No – Decker. Approved.
 - (10) STREET CLOSURE – Motion made by Wyatt to allow the Blank Agency to close a portion of street directly in front of 603 California from 7 am to 12:30 pm on Saturday, July 18, 2020 for an auction, seconded by Zwingman. RCV: Yes – Zwingman, Rutjens, Smidt, Navratil, Decker, Wyatt. No – None. Approved.
 - (11) TOWER PAINTING – Wyatt made a motion to approve the quote by Maguire Iron in the amount of \$56,850 for interior painting and repairs to water tower, seconded by Rutjens. RCV: Yes – Wyatt, Zwingman, Rutjens, Smidt. No – Navratil, Decker. Approved.
 - (12) INSURANCE – Reviewed insurance quotes, tabled until a future date.
 - (13) POND – Motion made by Wyatt, seconded by Decker to purchase from keno funds an aerating fountain in the amount of \$2,099. RCV: Yes – Smidt, Rutjens, Zwingman, Wyatt, Decker, Navratil. No – None. Approved. Park committee will look into a new swing set for the duck pond area up to the amount of \$5,000.
 - (9) 1ST STREET PAY APPLICATION – Motion made by Zwingman to approve the 1st pay request from A&R Construction in the amount of \$384,100.21, seconded by Smidt. RCV: Yes – Navratil, Decker, Wyatt, Zwingman, Smidt. No – None. Abstain – Rutjens. Approved. Motion made by Navratil to spend up to \$2,500 for additional drainage near Will's Paint and Body, seconded by Smidt. RCV: Yes – Navratil, Decker, Wyatt, Zwingman, Smidt. No – None. Abstain – Rutjens. Approved.
 - (14) NUISANCE PROPERTIES – Discussion on properties.
- With no further business to come before the council, Rutjens made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Decker. Meeting was adjourned at 9:14 pm.
